- 6. What links does Camus make between authoritarian fascism and plague?
- 7. Would you personally take the risks accepted by Dr. Rieux and continued a daily work schedule despite being surrounded by disease, misery, and death?
- 8. Do you think the COVID-19 pandemic showed us our common humanity? Why or why not?
- 9. The Plague by and large ignores structural inequalities and racism that have produced differential impact and outcomes in today's pandemic. What do you think is missing in Camus' analysis?
- 10. What are the lessons we can learn from The Plague?
