COMMENTS TO EDITOR: This is a clever but not especially insightful poem about blood. It is not a bad poem, but it is not a terrific poem. Although the reviewers each recommend "minor revision," if you read their comments, they are not at all enthusiastic. I especially agree with their insight that FM is about patient, learner, and clinician stories, so that this seems a bit remote and precious.

COMMENTS TO AUTHOR: While the poem is clever ("What am I?"), it is a bit too abstract for the journal, which focuses on patients,' students,' and clinicians' stories. While it offers a good description of blood, it does not sufficiently connect blood (despite the reference to "love") to the "heart" if you will of family medicine.
